

Tuition is the next largest source of revenue, followed by tuition assistance and fundraising. New Students First legislation and Education Savings Accounts (ESA) for families will have a positive impact on SFC and will continue to impact families, our school, and our parish as all families will qualify for ESA's in the year 2025–2026. For Fiscal Year 2023–2024, 61% of our students qualified and received an ESA.
